

I. AMENDMENT OF THE BYLAW

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

Section 2. The authorized number of Board directors shall be *nine (9)* directors until changed by an amendment to the Bylaws adopted by the vote or written consent of the majority of NSCS membership. *Eight (8)* directors shall be elected *by members at the annual general membership meetings (AGMM)* and one (1) director *who shall be a teacher representative elected by NSCS teachers of the given year.* All elected directors shall take office effective July 1 after the official election result is announced.

Section 3. Each director position shall have a term of two (2) years with *four (4)* positions elected one year and *another four (4)* the next. Any director can be removed without cause by a simple majority vote by the Board of Directors or a simple majority vote by NSCS members during AGMM or special membership meeting.

Section 6. A majority of the authorized number of directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of Board business. If less than such majority is present at a meeting, a majority of the directors present may adjourn the meeting from time to time without further notice. A quorum shall not be less than *five (5)* of the *nine (9)* authorized directors except in the event that there is more than one vacancy on the Board of Directors, at which time *four (4)* directors may constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VI – ADMINISTRATIVE AND TEACHING STAFF

Section 2. The Chair of the Board of Directors shall be the Principal and the Vice-Chair of the Board of Directors shall be the Vice-Principal *for Academic Affairs.* Their terms are subject to the terms stipulated in Section 8, Article V of the Bylaws.

Section 4. *A second Vice-Principal shall be appointed from the member-elected board of directors and shall be in charge of Logistics.* The Vice-Principals assist the Principal in administrating NSCS affairs and, in the absence of the Principal, shall become the acting Principal.
